PUBLIC NOTICE

The Regional Municipality of Durham will be proceeding with road resurfacing on Brock Road (Regional Road 1), from the south side of Dellbrook Avenue to 160 metres south of Rossland Road, in the City of Pickering.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The Region's contractor, Coco Paving Incorporated, will mobilize their equipment and personnel on site to commence work on Oct. 22, and are expected to complete the work by Nov. 14. Please note that unfavourable weather conditions may influence the work schedule.

LANE RESTRICTIONS AND ROAD CLOSURE

Daily lane restrictions on Brock Road are required for the duration of the project in order to complete the work in a safe and efficient manner. Dellbrook Avenue will be closed between Brock Road and Melman Street, during construction hours for two days, to accommodate the paving operations at the intersection of Brock Road and Dellbrook Avenue. Access will be maintained to the shopping plaza located at the southwest corner of Brock Road and Dellbrook Avenue. Drivers are asked to exercise additional caution for their safety, and the safety of the construction workers.

The Region realizes that the work will be disruptive and will make every effort to complete the work as quickly and efficiently as possible.
