**Re: Southeast Collector Trunk Sewer Construction
Shaft 5 – Rosebank Road, South of Third Concession Road**

Dear Resident / Property Owner:

The Regional Municipality of York is proceeding with construction of the Southeast Collector Trunk Sewer in accordance with the Environmental Assessment Report, approved on March 31, 2010. The new Southeast Collector Trunk Sewer will support provincially mandated growth in York Region and will allow wastewater from the existing trunk sewer to be diverted to allow for condition assessments and rehabilitation of the existing trunk sewer. This work will benefit York and Durham Regions.

Work in your area will begin in March with the establishment of a temporary construction compound (Shaft 5) on the east side of Rosebank Road approximately mid-way between Finch Avenue and Third Concession Road (see attached map). The compound will be in place for approximately three years and will accommodate equipment and materials necessary for shaft construction.

Construction will be limited to the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Saturday. The contractor has already begun enclosing the construction compound with 12-foot solid fencing to reduce sound and minimize the visual impact of the site. There are no anticipated impacts to traffic, as the majority of the work will take place within the limits of the construction compound.
